Next years date has been set for Tuesday 8th March 2016, keep a look out on our website for next years programme.



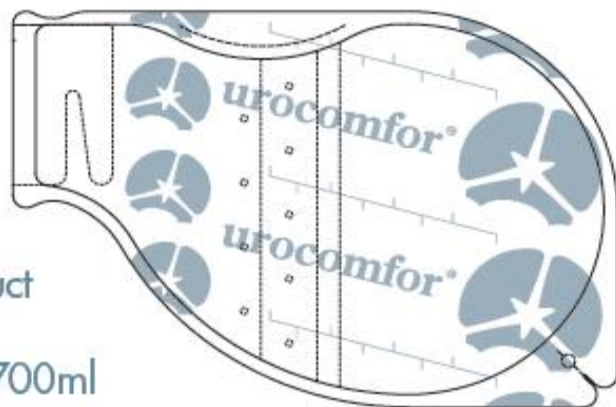
